Bob Vaughn from the School Committee appeared before the Board to discuss the school committee's desire to submit a Statement of Interest to the MA School Building Authority for the LMMHS. The deadline is April 29 for submission, but if they are not ready, they will plan to apply next year.

By roll call, DR, MM, EL and WA voted to go into Executive Session at 6:21pm to discuss strategy with respect to litigation as discussing such strategy in public session may have a detrimental impact on the Town's negotiating position.
