MOTION by MM, seconded by EL to grant permission to the Gateways Inn to erect a sandwich board sign in front of their business at 51 Walker Street. 3/0 vote with MS abstaining.

At the April 26 meeting, Shots Café came before the Board seeking an alteration of premises on their annual Wine & Malt Restaurant license. They would like to include outdoor service on their patio, offering six tables with a limit of two chairs per table. Attorney Jeff Lynch made a presentation to the Board, but the Board agreed that they needed to look into the matter further, and voted to continue the public hearing until tonight. There are still some outstanding issues, and counsel for Shots Café asked that the Board continue the hearing until their June 7 meeting. EL stated that the flags hung in Lenox Dale were paid for by the Fire Company and have been well received. DR stated that the VFW placed flags in the cemetery, and then he went on to read the information for both the Lenox Dale and Lenox Memorial Day parades.
