BOS Reports: NM stated that the Planning Board has their revised by-law ready for the town meeting warrant. WA stated that he has been looking at problem trees with the utility company. EL mentioned the passing of John Pignatelli, and what a fine gentleman he was. NM stated that he thought that it was very nice that the DPW stood outside next to their trucks during the procession.
