- g. Special event signs in residential districts are limited to one free-standing sign per event per property not more than six (6) square feet in area and one one-sided, on-building sign per event per property not more than six (6) square feet in area. Commercial uses in residential districts shall be in accordance with Section 7.2.9.5.h or Section 7.2.9.5.i.
- h. Special event signs in the C district are limited to one free-standing sign—per event per property not more than six (6) square feet in area and one one-sided, on-building sign per event per property not more than six (6) square feet in area. Residential uses in commercial districts shall be in accordance with Section 7.2.9.5.g.
- i. Special event signs in the C-1A, C-3A and I districts are limited to one free-standing sign per event per property not more than six (6) square feet in area and one one-sided, on-building sign-per event per property not more than six (6) square feet in area. Residential uses in commercial districts shall be in accordance with Section 7.2.9.5.g.
