

Clarifying Amendment - Weekend/Holiday Details

It has come to our attention that important language was accidentally omitted from the final contract between the Town and the Patrolman's union (MCOP). The language was relative to time-and-a-half rates for details performed on weekends and holidays. It was not our intention to omit this language and, as a matter of good faith bargaining, I am asking that the Board approve the following amendment:

Amend Article III, paragraph A. by inserting the following sentence at the end of the paragraph:

"For hours worked on Saturdays, Sundays, or legally recognized holidays, officers will earn 1.5 times the hourly detail rate."




