

Proposed Zoning Bylaw Amendments: Agricultural Uses

Key updates to the existing bylaw on Agricultural Uses:

- Brings Agricultural Uses into compliance with state law.
- Considers how residents are using and want to use land for agricultural purposes:
 - Revises standards for Large Commercial and Small Commercial Farms.
 - Proposes new standards for Commercial Farm Stands in Residential districts.
 - Allows “Backyard Chickens” in all Residential districts, with guidelines.
 - Recognizes and regulates small Neighborhood Farm Stands.

Please note: Commercial marijuana grow operations are not part of this bylaw – they are subject to different regulations.
